



ISMART MASSAGER

Company & Location: The company you will be working for, **Mirage Inc.**, owns and operates kiosks for the iSmart Massager. Students will be assigned to a Kiosk and a location and will be in charge of demonstration and reaching targeted sales numbers for the iSmart SoCool Massager.

- iSmart SoCool Massager: is a portable, personal massager that utilizes Electronic Muscle Stimulation, or EMS, powered by a common 9 volt battery. EMS is the process whereby mild electric pulses are sent to a specific muscle or group causing it to contract. EMS has been used in the field of medicine to treat atrophy and many other conditions and is currently being utilized by Chiropractors, Sports Trainers and Physical Therapists around the world. However, with six variable strength levels, three separate modes of operation, ease of use and nominal size (about as small as a PC mouse) the iSmart Massager SoCool is well designed for personal, practical use.

Job Opportunities: SALES - The position involves approaching shoppers and encouraging them to stop and try the products. You will be working 8 to 11 hours per day, standing most of the day. You must possess strong selling and customer service skills. The position requires someone enthusiastic, passionate and able to demonstrate and sell our products in the fast-paced retail/kiosk environment.

- **Pay Rate** - \$7.25 or 25% commission on all sales
- **Work Hours** – 30 hours per week average, however students on commission pay may pick up as many additional hours as they like
- **Work Shifts** – Must be available to work all shifts and positions seven days per week including weekends & holidays
- **Job Start Date** –November 20—December 15, 2010 **Job End Date** – March 1—April 1, 2011
- **Advance - Fluent English required** as you will need to sell to clients, answer questions and produce demonstrations
